Note:

The heats for the Timed Finals will be seeded based on times submitted by individual zones and placings in these events will be based on times swum in these events. All results will be displayed underneath the eastern side of the grandstand as soon as possible after the event.

Warm-up Procedures:

Swimmers will be permitted to warm-up in the Competition Pool as soon as possible after 2.30pm. NO DIVING will be permitted in the competition pool during warm up with the exception of Lane 0 and 9.

The warm-up pool (Diving Pool) will be available throughout the day. However, there is to be NO DIVING.

PRIMARY SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

- 1 All swimming rules in accordance with NSWASA except where a specific Sydney East rule applies.
- 2 Failure to comply with these rules or obey the orders of officials will result in disqualification.
- 3 All competitors must be members of official zone or affiliated teams.
- 4 Entry:
All competitors must be members of zone teams

Zones may enter three competitors in 50m Freestyle events.

Each zone/district is entitled to enter a third swimmer in the 50m Formstroke, 100m Freestyle and 4x50m Relay events provided that all three have bettered the qualifying time. The qualifying times, based on the previous year's Sydney East Carnival, will be distributed to Zone/District Conveners prior to the carnival.

Entry into the 200m Individual Medley events require all swimmers to have achieved the qualifying time at their respective Zone/District Carnival. Each Zone is permitted to enter a maximum of 3 competitors in the 200m Individual Medley.

In each event up to four additional competitors from each zone may be included who meet the 5th placed time from the previous year's Sydney East Carnival.
- 5 The ONE START rule will apply at the Sydney East championships.
The one start rule will apply at the NSWPSA state championship.
- 6 It is the responsibility of competitors to report to the marshals when their event is called.
- 7 All spectators must remain in their designated area.
- 8 No limitation of events except for age restrictions.
- 9 A competitor whose significant birthday occurs during the current year is eligible for that age group only.

No competitor shall enter in more than one age division except for All Age events i.e. 100m freestyle. Please note, this rule also applies to relays and Individual Medley events.

AGE GROUPS: 8 years - born 2012, 9 years - born 2011, 10 years - born 2010, 11 years - born 2009, 12 years - born 2008, 13 years - born 2007.
- 10 Placings in all events will be decided on times swum in the heats, which will be seeded based on times submitted from zone carnivals, and conducted as timed finals.
- 11 All protests must be lodged in writing within ten minutes of the event by the zone team managers, who must be a teacher.

12 NSWPSSA rules take precedence in any disputes.

13 PROGRAM: The championship manager reserves the right to alter the program if this is deemed necessary.

SELECTION POLICY

Students must compete at the Sydney East carnival in order to allow them to be considered for selection in the team to compete at the NSWPSSA state championships, unless they are:

i) competing at a higher level school sporting competition.

In this case, a request for consideration for inclusion in the Sydney East team must be presented to the convener at least one week prior to the Sydney East carnival. This is to be verified/endorsed by the student's Principal and Zone/District convener listing the student's Zone/District performance.

The student's Zone/District performance will be scored against the competitors at the Sydney East carnival. Inclusion in the Sydney East team under these circumstances is subject to meeting the relevant NSWPSSA entry processes. Submitting a consideration for inclusion does not guarantee inclusion in the Sydney East team.

ii) the first three place getters will be considered for selection into the Sydney East representative team. In case of a tie for third place the convener shall determine selection for the third position by having a swim-off between the competitors concerned.
