## For students with disability

The School Sport Unit Ten Pin Bowling competition will be back in 2022!

By adapting the game to utilise lane bumpers and ramps as needed, it ensures the game is inclusive of all. No formal sporting classification is required to participate, giving greater opportunity to students with disability.

Schools may enter a team of four students in the state-wide competition, which will have a Primary and Secondary division. Schools for Special Purpose and Central Schools may enter a team in both the primary and secondary competitions as per their enrolments.

Competitions will begin at local venues in Term 3, with representatives from each region qualifying for the final, to be held in Sydney, in mid Term 4. Teams will then play off for the inaugural title of Inclusive School Sport State Champions!
