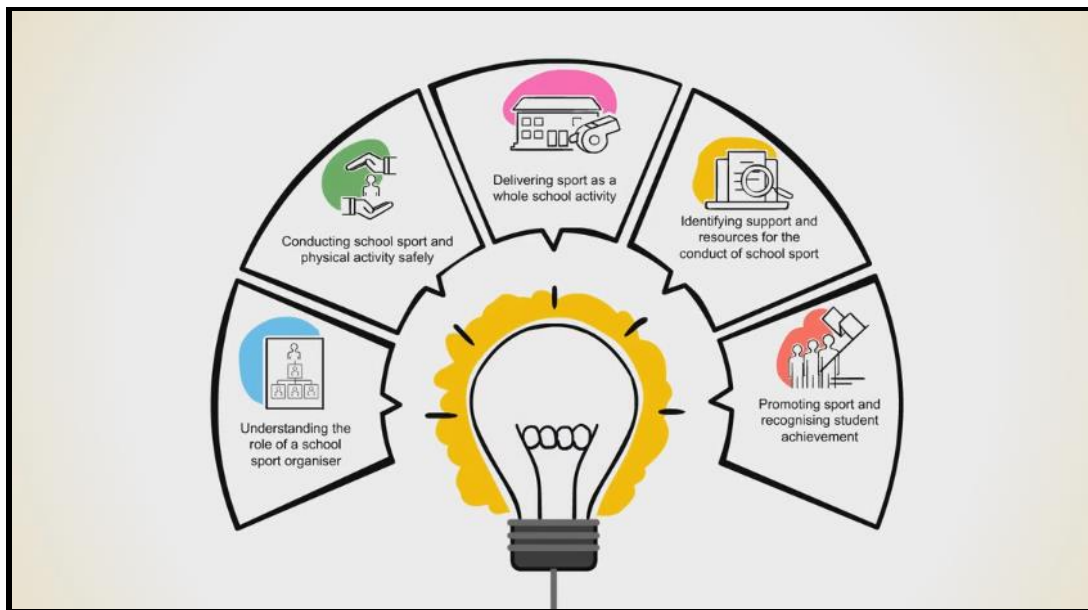
- New to the role of a sport organiser?

- range from 3 -5 hours of accreditation at the Proficient career stage
- are separate courses and can be completed in any order
- can be completed in a non-consecutive topic order
- each course has a cost of \$44.00 per teacher
- develops a learning portfolio that participants have lifetime access to
- require a suitable mentor to support and verify their professional learning.
